Additional Family	All benefits as listed in regular family membership Must be a family member living with individuals listed in regular family membership	\$34
Adult	Skater must be 18 years or older All benefits listed in regular family membership	\$110
Introductory	For skaters who have never previously registered with any USFS club Valid for one time only All benefits listed in regular family membership PLUS 10 hours of club ice	\$145/ skater
Professional	For USFS coaches only Includes USFS Membership and Skating Magazine Teaching privileges on FSCC club ice Priority consideration for group classes, etc for FSCC home club coaches Permission to skate on club ice	\$95
Collegiate	For full-time college students 4-year membership with FSCC and USFS All benefits listed in regular family membership	\$120
FSCC Activity Registration	For anyone (skater or coach) who is not a USFS member. Enables participation in the following activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FSCC-managed freestyle and summer ice sessions (but NOT club ice sessions) • Group activity (e.g. Ice Show Team, Group lessons) • Basic skills or beginner levels of competition (must not have passed any USFS tests) Includes USFS Basic Skills Membership Does NOT include testing privileges.
