- Walk-On Rates
  - Member:
    - \$16 per hour (50 minutes or less)
    - \$24 per 1.5 hours (51-80 minutes)
  - Non- Member:
    - \$17 per hour (50 minutes or less)
    - \$25.50 per 1.5 hours (51-80 minutes) for non-members.
- All You Can Skate ice package can be used on any FSCC session during the 2018-2019 skating season (September 2018 – May 2019)
- The more ice you commit to purchase, the lower your hourly rate!
- A skating hour is one 50-minute period.
