*US Figure Skating:* The Cincinnati Ice Show Team is a program of the Figure Skating Club of Cincinnati (FSCC). FSCC is a member club of U.S. Figure Skating (USFS). Therefore, we will follow USFS National Showcase rules when applicable.

*ISI:* The Cincinnati Ice Show Team will be a member of the Ice Skating Institute (ISI), which is another figure skating governing body. We join ISI under the Kettering Adult Skating Club ISI membership. We will also follow ISI rules.

In both USFS and ISI, show teams focus on performance skills (not technical skills), and embrace skaters of all skill levels and ages.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Members of the Cincinnati Ice Show Team:

- Must be members of US Figure Skating.
- Must be members in good standing of the Figure Skating Club of Cincinnati (FSCC), but need not be home club members. USFS and FSCC online membership is here: <http://comp.entryeeze.com/Membership/Welcome.aspx?cid=24>
- Must be members of ISI. ISI membership link is here: [http://www.skateisi.com/site/sub.cfm?content=membership\\_individual](http://www.skateisi.com/site/sub.cfm?content=membership_individual)
- Must sign a commitment letter, waivers and medical emergency forms.

There are no age or test restrictions to skate on this show team.

  - c. (Deposit and 1<sup>st</sup> payment totaling \$190 are due 11/2/14)
2. If skater is new to the club, was NOT part of the Show Team last year, and did NOT have any other membership with FSCC, they will need to go to “New Members” and click on Apply for Membership. Make an account and follow online instructions.
3. If skater was a previous member of the Show Team, go to “Existing Members” and click on *Access my account* to renew membership from last year.
4. Members who have a home club other than FSCC and do not need access to FSCC testing privileges will need the Team/Group Membership only.

Attendance is required at all practices, competitions and performances, only to be excused by illness, injury or coach permission. Please arrive early to all activities and do a sufficient warm-up. Use good manners and leave the area cleaner than when you got there. Absent or late skaters will affect the entire team’s progress!

Parades and events are voluntary and used to provide a community service while promoting the team, FSCC, Cincinnati Skating School and our skating community. They are lots of fun. Family and friends are encouraged to join us!

At competitions, please display good sportsmanship at all times. Cheer on team members participating in additional events. The support of our team members is crucial to team spirit and

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motivation, and is FUN!! Encourage your fellow competitors and offer your applause and support to all skaters and teams. Teams are always watched by other skaters; do your best to set a good example!

### **TRAVEL**

Most of the team's exhibitions and competitions will be in the Greater Cincinnati area. Our furthest appearance will be in Owensboro, KY.

Before each appearance, team members will be provided with a schedule and logistics information, which will clearly explain where skaters need to be at what time.

Hotels – Hotels will not be arranged by the team for local appearances. Hotel information will be provided for out-of-town competitions. Individuals will make their own lodging arrangements.

Transportation - Skaters generally arrange to carpool with other members of the team or make individual transportation plans. Please review the official schedule (available from the Travel Manager or Coach) before making final arrangements.

Meals - You provide your own meals. If a Team Meal is scheduled, please make every effort to attend.

### **ATTIRE**

As a member of the Cincinnati Ice Show Team, you are expected to dress neatly, respectfully, and appropriately for the occasion.

Team Jackets - You are not required to purchase a Show Team jacket, but there will be an option to add Show Team patches to the FSCC club jackets. If you have a team jacket, please wear it to all team events. You may also wear Show Team jackets from previous years. Jackets are not included in the 2013-2014 budget but patches are.

Practice attire – Please dress in skating attire appropriate for moving on and off the ice. Please dress according to the rink temperature. Gloves and layered outerwear are suggested. Please wear socks, dance shoes or go barefoot for off-ice rehearsals (flip-flops and street shoes are not allowed). The coach will inform you if specific practice attire is required.

Competition attire – a costume will be designed and made/purchased for each team member. There is a costume allowance in the 2014-2015 budget, which will be included in the monthly team fees. You will be informed if additional costume fees become necessary. Please do not wear any jewelry while competing, including non-costume earrings, necklaces, bracelets, rings, and watches. If you always wear your wedding ring, another piece of jewelry or medical tag/equipment, please cushion or secure it with a bandage for safety if necessary. Please keep ungloved fingernails tidy and safely trimmed for performances.

### **COMMUNICATION**

Team Roster - A team roster will be prepared by the Communications Manager.

Mailing List - All team members will be enrolled in an online mailing list. This group will be the team's primary method of communication. Please check your e-mail regularly.

### FINANCES

Team fees are handled by adding up the expected expenses, and dividing by the number of skaters on the team.

- The following team expenses are included in monthly dues: ice time, coaching, exhibition/competition entry fees, costume, sets and props.
- The following individual expenses are NOT included in monthly dues: skating tights, travel expenses (if any), FSCC/ISI personal memberships.

Fees for 2014-2015 are *estimated* to be \$95/month (4 months), plus a \$95 deposit (\$475 total), based on 14 skaters. A final fee calculation will be done once the number of skaters and the performances and competitions are finalized. At the end of the season, if a significant overage or shortage is expected, the final payment may be adjusted to compensate.

Those able to participate in fundraising may use their fundraising efforts to lessen their total fees. We will be selling [Butterbraid](#) for our fundraiser. See schedule for dates.

A \$95 deposit is due when you commit to skate on the team (by November 2, 2014).

Monthly payments are due:

- Nov 2 - \$95 plus \$95 deposit (\$190)
- Dec 7 - \$95
- Jan 4 - \$95
- Feb 8 - \$95 (Final payment. This will be adjusted after totals have been calculated.)

**A \$5 late fee will be applied to all payments made after the due date.**

Checks should be made out to "FSCC." Online payment and late fee information to be announced. Otherwise, payments should be given to the Show Team Treasurer, Gemma Steinkamp at rehearsals to ensure they will be properly recorded and credited to the correct skater.

### INJURY

In the event of an injury, the following financial policies shall apply in order to protect the skater and his/her teammates:

- If an injury has been determined by the attending physician as **season ending**:
  - A. If injury occurs before November 9, 2014, monthly skating dues are owed through the month in which the injury occurred.
  - B. If injury occurs after November 9, 2014, the skater must pay all monthly fees through the end of the season.
- If an injury is **not season ending**:
  - A. All financial obligations must be met, and the skater is expected to attend and observe practices to stay abreast of program changes.

### TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

If a skater wishes to resign from the team:

- \* Before November 9, 2014:
  1. Sign "Termination of Membership Form" and give to the Team Treasurer.
  2. Pay monthly skating dues for the entire month during which the skater departs the team.

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3. Pay skater’s share of competition fees, if the team has submitted competition fees before the date of the skater’s departure.
- ✳ On or after November 9, 2014:
1. Sign “Termination of Membership Form” and give to the Team Treasurer for signature.
  2. Pay all monthly fees through the end of the season.

In any case of termination, all fees are due to the team treasurer within 15 days of notification of fees owed. Treasurer will notify departing skater within 30 days of the departure of the skater, where possible, of any outstanding balance or refund due. Refunds, if due to the departing skater, shall be remitted as funds become available.

**RESPONSIBILITIES**

All team members are expected to contribute to the success of the team—both on and off the ice. Therefore, we ask each team member (or a parent) to lead or assist with one of the roles described below.

Roles may be adjusted each season, depending on the needs of the team. Typical roles include:
