A few things to keep in mind as you choose your ice package:

- * Each skater must have his or her own ice package (or pay the walk-on rate).
- * Ice time can be used on any FSCC/CSS/NKY/SP freestyle summer session during the 2016 summer season (June 2016 – August 2016)
- * The walk-on rate is always \$12 per 50-60 minute (hour.) If you outskate your package, you may elect to upgrade to another package, or pay to walk on at regular hourly rate
- * The more ice you commit to purchase, the lower your hourly rate!
- * A SKATING HOUR IS ONE 50-MINUTE PERIOD. Occasionally it may be more due to ice cuts, but it is not guaranteed.
