

Rules of Etiquette and Right of Way

## **GENERAL ETIQUETTE RULES**

- 1. Please do not enter the ice until it is prepared and ready for use. Also, please remember to look both ways before stepping on.
- 2. Skaters <u>must be moving at all times</u>. All conversation should occur at the side of the boards or off the rink.
- 3. Skaters must be <u>alert and mindful of other skaters</u> on the ice at all times to avoid collisions and annoyances to others.
- 4. Power skating for hockey players is only permitted in a lesson.
- 5. Except for lessons sponsored by FSCC, no more than 2 skaters in a lesson at a time.
- 6. Group skating and games (e.g. tag, racing, etc.) are not appropriate at any time!
- 7. Please use common sense and courtesy.
- 8. Please check the member attendance sheet and sign yourself and any guests in at the beginning of the ice session.

## RULES OF RIGHT OF WAY

These rules apply to <u>ALL Freestyle and Dance</u> skaters! Please note there will no longer be Dance Priority Sessions.

- Please yield to the Freestyle or Dance skater:
  - $\circ$  who is in a harness lesson
  - $\circ$  whose music is playing and/or is wearing the vest or sash
  - $\circ$  as a matter of common courtesy, is in a lesson
- Outside of a lesson, skaters who are playing their music/practicing their programs should only <u>expect to have the right of way once per session.</u>

Members or guests who do not follow the FSCC Rules of Etiquette and Right of Way may be asked to leave the ice.
